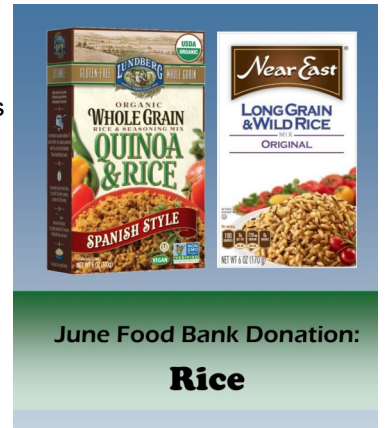
**The Cribbage Tournament's** 8th night is Wednesday, May 31, here at 7 pm.
