

Sunshine graces a successful 5K Run/Walk

As announced by Run/Walk Coordinator Peggy Siegle on May 7, "Run and Walk revenues pass the \$34,000 goal!" Gross revenues on that date were \$34,067 counting \$4,850 in business sponsors; \$1,250 in Runner registrations and \$1,651 in sponsor money for runners; \$24,470 in walker sponsor money; and \$1,780 and change in online and miscellaneous donations.

Downeast Energy Fuel Discount**

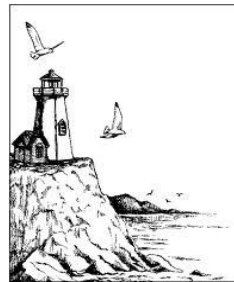
Since Elijah Kellogg Church purchases its fuel from Downeast Energy, Downeast is providing a \$.15 cent per gallon discount to Elijah Kellogg Church members.

The enclosed sheet shows the rates for three plans (hard copies also available at the church).

Regardless of the method you purchase your fuel, you are eligible for the discount.

You must contact Downeast @729-9921 to set up your plan contract.

If you call by June 28, 2013 the rates printed on the enclosed sheet apply. If you call after June 28th, you will still be eligible for the \$.15 discount until July 10, 2013. However, the discount will be off the then-contract rate.
