INTRODUCTION TO SCRIPTURE

A READING FROM THE EPISTLES — Hebrews 5:5-10 [ILV]

[5] Christ, even the Christ, did not presume to take on the office of high priest. No, Christ was appointed by the One Who said,

"You are my Own,

today I have begotten you";

[6] and in another place that One said,

"You are a priest forever, according to

the order of Melchizedek."

[7] In the days of this One's flesh, Jesus offered up prayers and supplications, with loud cries and tears, to the God, Who was able to save the Rabbi from death, and Jesus was heard because of reverent submission. [8] Though firstborn, Jesus learned to obey through suffering. [9] But, having been made perfect, Jesus became, for all who obey, the source of eternal salvation, [10] and designated by God to be a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.

INTRODUCTION TO SCRIPTURE

A READING FROM THE GOSPELS — John 12:20-33 [ILV]

[20] Now among those who went up to worship at the festival, at the Passover, were some Greeks. [21] They approached Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and put forth this request, "Please— we wish to see Jesus." [22] Philip went and told Andrew; then Andrew and Philip went and told Jesus. [23] Jesus answered them,

"The hour has come for the Chosen One to be glorified. [24] The truth of the matter is, unless a grain of wheat falls on the ground and dies, it remains only a single grain; but if it dies, it bears much fruit,

it yields a rich harvest. [25] Those who love their life will lose it. and those who hate their life in this world will keep it for eternal life. [26] Whoever serves me, anyone who works for me must follow me, must follow in my footsteps and wherever I am, my worker will be there too. Anyone who works for me will be honored by Abba, God. [27] Now my soul is troubled. What will I say— 'Abba, save me from this hour'? No, it is for this reason that I have come to this hour. [28]*Abba*, glorify Your name!" Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again." [29] The crowd standing there heard it and some said that it was thunder. Others said, "It was an angel speaking." [30] Jesus answered, "This voice has come for your sake, not for mine. [31] Sentence is now being passed on this world; now the ruler of this world will be overthrown. [32] And I, when I am lifted up from this earth, I will draw all people to myself." [33] These words of Jesus indicated the kind of death he would die.


