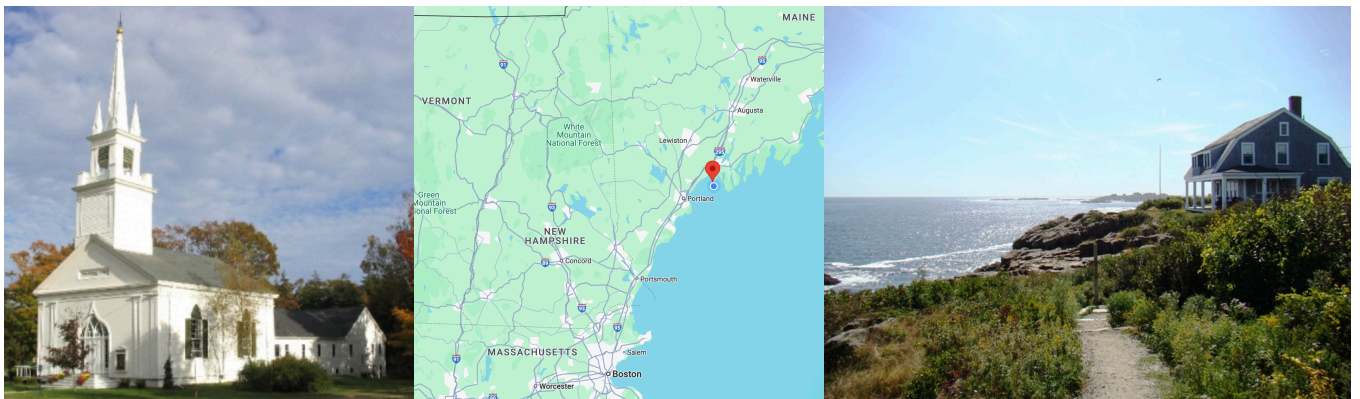


Elijah Kellogg Church

- Harpswell is a classic picturesque fishing town, situated in Maine's Midcoast region, 40 miles northeast of Portland.



- We have a three-bedroom, three-bathroom parsonage on the church's 47-acre property.
